Promoting sanitation across CALABARZON: **Laguna Water joins the DILG Sanitation Summit**

As one of the accredited service providers in promoting sanitation and sewage and septage management in Laguna, Laguna Water joined the recently conducted forum of DILG Region IV-A entitled "Forum and Partnership Setting for Recycling Industries and for the Management of Septage Treatment Facility.'

Ms. Precios Jill Lucina, Used Water Operations Manager, showcased Laguna Water's innovative practices in sanitation and shared exciting developments in desludging. The company's Sewage and Septage Treatment Plant (SSTP) located inside Binan Technopark can cater to 11 million liters of sewage per day and 135 cubic meters of septage per day. Currently, the company has nine units of desludging trucks which can cater Laguna Water customers from Biñan, Santa Rosa, Cabuyao, Pagsanjan, Santa Cruz, Victoria, San Pablo, Alaminos and Calamba.

The forum held at Hotel Casiana, Tagaytay City, Cavite, aimed to promote the importance of proper solid waste and wastewater management throughout CALABARZON. Moreover, it also connected local government units included in the Manila Bay Rehabilitation Program and accredited service providers.

Along with the forum is the awarding of the 2022 Manila BAYani Awards and Incentives, where the City of Biñan was hailed as the 2022 Top 1 Performing Local Government Unit & Champion of Best Environmental Practices Audio-Visual Presentation Making Contest (City Category). As the sanitation partner of Biñan City in implementing and promoting desludging services to the community, Laguna Water is grateful for the city's award. This is a testament to a fruitful partnership in implementing environmental practices and initiatives that support national goals and strategic thrusts.

As an active member of the watershed management councils headed by the Laguna Lake Development Authority (LLDA) and the City Environment and Natural Resources Office (City ENRO) of Santa Rosa, Biñan, and Cabuyao, Laguna Water supported the activities and programs of the said management councils.

As part of the company's commitment to sustainably manage the water sources and to establish connections among the members of the Biñan, San Pedro, Silang, GMA, Carmona, and Tagaytay (BiSSigCaTa) Watershed Management Council, Laguna Water participated in the Action Planning Workshop held last August at Sol Y Viento Resort Calamba, Laguna. The workshop aimed to formulate the vision, mission, goals, and objectives of the BiSSigCaTa Watershed Management Council. Moreover, the workshop developed strategic actions and plans and assigned responsibilities to stakeholders and council members

In another event headed by BiSSigCaTa Watershed Management Council and as part of the celebration of National Environmental Awareness Month in November, Laguna Water also participated in a clean-up drive in Barangay Dela Paz, Biñan City. With this environmental clean-up, the spread of garbage to Laguna Lake is hoped to be reduced.

Meanwhile, the Santa Rosa Watershed Management Council (SWMC) also conducted a two-day Project development and Writeshop at Monte Vista Resort, Los Banos, Laguna last November. The writeshop was intended to guide the council members in developing proposals that may help improve the water quality of Laguna Lake and its tributaries.

And lastly, being an active member of the Cabuyao River Protection Advocates (CaRPA), Laguna Water joined in the Multisectoral Environmental Community Engagement: Maglinis at Mag-aral para sa Kalikasan at Pamayanan", a multisectoral clean-up and environmental education endeavor aimed to increase environmental awareness and involvement of the community. The activity involves the River Clean-up with Tree Planting Activity and Environmental Education on proper sanitation and managing solid, household hazardous, and liquid wastes. The event was held last November in Barangay Banlic, Cabuyao City.

As input to the students' science subject, volunteers also share vital information on waste management, specifically on domestic wastewater treatment and solid waste segregation. Learners are, likewise, reminded of the importance of clean water in maintaining proper hygiene and overall wellness.

Painting smiles on innocent faces:


The Daloy ng Saya tradition continues to brighten the Christmas spirit among school children in Laguna

This year, Laguna Water's annual gift-giving and IEC program, Daloy ng Saya, brought joy to over 300 public elementary students, showcasing our commitment to the community.

Beyond the gifts and festivities, the Daloy ng Saya program provided students with valuable knowledge on water conservation, waste management, oral hygiene, and sanitation. From December 4 - 13, our employee volunteers were thrilled to engage with students in selected elementary schools across Biñan, Santa Rosa, Cabuyao, Pagsanjan, and Pakil. In addition to the learning sessions and gift packs, schools were also equipped with WASHup! Portable Handwashing Stations in partnership with Manila Water Foundation.

Aside from Laguna Water donations and volunteers, this year's Daloy ng Saya was also co-sponsored by the Cabuyao City LGU through the Cabuyao City Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) and the Rotary Club of Cabuyao Circle. The events were also participated by Pagsanjan Water District, Pakil Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO), and Cabuyao River Protection Advocated (CaRPA).





Laguna Water, a Manila Water operating subsidiary providing water, used water, and environmental services in several municipalities in Laguna, has recently declared and paid out dividends to its shareholders, including the Provincial Government of Laguna (PGL), for the year 2022. The PGL received dividends amounting to PHP186 million.

The dividend sharing is one of the significant advantages of a fruitful Public-Private Partnership (PPP) agreement, as it allows the province to generate additional revenue from the water sector and allocate it for other local priorities and development projects. Aside from the dividend payout, the PGL and Laguna Water have also achieved notable milestones following the aspects of the PPP agreement, including improved water supply and sanitation services especially on water quality and pressure, lower Non-Revenue Water (NRW) levels or system losses, better customer service and billing system, implementation of various environmental and social programs to empower and uplift its customers and stakeholders and to protect Laguna's natural resources, among others.

Currently, Laguna Water has expanded its service areas, from three (3) to eleven (11) cities and municipalities in the said province.



We are honored to share the dividends with PGL, which reflects our fruitful relationship and collaboration. We believe that PPP effectively and efficiently delivers essential public services, such as water and sanitation, to our fellow Lagunenses. We look forward to more years of successful cooperation with PGL and other local government units in Laguna.

Laguna Water intensifies its support in making communities safer from communicable diseases. In partnership with Manila Water Foundation and P&G Philippines, 7,200 pieces of Safeguard soaps were distributed between the months of August to November 2023.

The campaign kicked off in Laguna through the donation of 25 boxes (1,800 pcs) of soaps to the province through the office of the Provincial Governor, Hon. Ramil Hernandez. The campaign continued in the municipalities of Lumban, Pila, and Calauan, and the cities of Santa Rosa and Binan.
